Footnotes

BETTER MAKE MONEY, bumped by KNIGHT SHOT at the start, raced unhurried tracking well off the second flight outside a rival in the opening stages, came under pressure to advance on the bend, angled five wide nearing midstretch to challenge and continued with a steady response to narrowly prevail under pressure. KNIGHT SHOT broke inwards, bumped BETTER MAKE MONEY, was quickly righted to dictate the pace along the inside, held sway on a narrow margin to late stages but couldn't fend off the winner. HELLIECAT, held up just off the second flight in the opening quarter, bid for command racing three wide into upper stretch but was outfinished between foes. TUF AO was rated just off the leaders in the opening stages, momentarily awaited an opening entering upper stretch, shifted out three deep leaving the furlong marker to challenge between foes but lacked the needed final kick. BACK TO GOLD tracked just off the first flight along the inside, saved ground to upper stretch but came up when called upon to challenge. UMBANI settled off the inside in the opening stages, angled six wide racing into the stretch and passed some tiring rivals. BARNEY BASS stalked just outside the pacesetter in the opening stages, pressed the issue between foes into upper stretch but came up empty nearing the furlong marker. DOUBLE JUMP tracked off the second flight along the inside racing to the bend but dropped out of contention early.
