Footnotes

COLOR ME BLUE raced under some reserve tracking off the second flight along the rail racing into the first turn, glanced off the rail entering the backstretch, saved ground on the second bend while moving into striking distance, angled three wide entering upper stretch, then drew on terms with the first flight and prevailed in the closing stages under firm right handed encouragement. MR. VEGAS, pulling a bit in the opening stages, tracked just off the pacesetter along the inside racing to the far turn, came through close quarters along the rail to challenge nearing the furlong marker and was just outkicked. TAZZ, forwardly placed from the break, tracked just off the pacesetter in hand racing to the far turn, bid between foes for command nearing midstretch but was outfinished by the top pair. GRIZZLED ROBERT settled in hand along the inside racing well off the leaders early, saved ground to upper stretch, angled out five wide leaving the furlong marker and made some belated progress. CARSON'S HONOR moved clear of his foes along the inside, set the pace on a clear margin into the far turn, briefly resisted several challengers but failed to sustain his momentum through the final sixteenth. NIC THE QUICK tracked the leaders unhurried near the inside from off the second flight early, angled six wide racing into upper stretch and made some mild progress. HOODWINKED tracked the pace unhurried outside foes racing to the backstretch, was caught four and five wide throughout and steadily faded from contention. TOO WILD FOR WORDS tracked the pace between foes off the second flight in the opening half, angled out four wide leaving the midway point of the far turn and faded from contention racing into upper stretch. SANTAMONICACANYON, reserved outside foes in the opening half racing three and four deep, never gained contention. PRAIRIE BREEZE, caught four wide tracking in second flight racing to the backstretch, continued with a steady bid three deep between foes racing into the second bend, steadied momentarily in traffic, then retreated nearing upper stretch. FAST ALEX, held up three wide between foes in the opening half, dropped out of contention early.
