Footnotes

GAGE PARK joined the first flight four deep racing into the first turn, angled inwards a bit nearing the backstretch to stalk just off the pacesetter, made steady progress on the far turn to press the issue racing into upper stretch and prevailed nearing the wire under steady pressure. TOQUINHO was urged to the lead three deep from between foes racing into the first turn, dictated the pace under some rating along the inside into the second bend, resisted the winner's challenge to late stages but came up second best. SHARP TRICK tracked off the second flight between foes in the opening half, made steady progress on the far turn, angled five wide entering upper stretch and continued willingly outside foes to gain a share. ARDANWOOD, forwardly placed between foes in the opening stages, tracked the leaders outside a rival as part of the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out nearing upper stretch to bid four wide between foes but was outkicked for a share. TRIPPIN' AWAY, forwardly placed inside foes racing into the first turn, tracked just off the pacesetter to the second bend, shifted out leaving the far turn to bid three deep between foes but couldn't produce the needed final bid. OUTLAW ZEN

tracked the leaders unhurried saving ground from just out of striking distance into the far turn, then continued evenly along the rail racing into upper stretch. HISTORIAN, reserved between foes tracking off the second flight to the far turn, couldn't produce the needed closing bid. SHOW YOUR FACE tracked off the second flight racing three and four wide into the backstretch, angled six wide entering upper stretch but couldn't gain striking distance. BRISTOL BOY, reserved off the inside in the opening half, was fanned seven deep racing into upper stretch but made no impression on the leaders. TO THE MOON settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and offered no rally. IZZA DEMON was never a factor.
