Footnotes

BATITO, bumped at the start, was quickly righted to gain a position outside foes just off the second flight in early stages, commenced a steady, three wide advance entering the bend to challenge for command in that path nearing upper stretch, wrested the advantage leaving the furlong marker and gamely held DEVIL IN DISGUISE to the end under right handed pressure and strong handling. The latter raced off the second flight between foes while unhurried in the opening stages, angled to the inside nearing the bend, shifted out four wide nearing upper stretch gathering momentum, moved to challenge in that path entering upper stretch and contested the issue to the end while proving only second best. MOST DISTINCT, forwardly placed along the inside, was eased off the leaders to track those foes in second flight racing into the turn, was shuffled a bit awaiting an opening nearing upper stretch, moved to challenge between foes leaving the furlong marker and was just outkicked by the top pair. MOSQUILLO went up to join the pace outside foes from the break, prompted a rival's pace racing into the turn, duelled inside foes racing into upper stretch and gave way leaving the furlong marker. BUDDY BE GOOD stumbled, then bumped the eventual winner at the start while righting himself, tracked off the second flight outside foes racing into the bend but had no closing bid. PUTTYKINS, brushed by the winner at the start, settled into stride near the inside and never gained contention. FLAMING AFFAIR tracked off the second flight along the inside in early stages but soon retreated from contention. GRAND SPORT was urged to the fore from between foes, angled to the rail setting the pace on a narrow margin racing into the turn and gave way in upper stretch.
