Footnotes

BAMBAZONKI was urged to secure the lead along the inside racing to the backstretch, dictated the pace on a clear margin into the second bend, moved well clear when prompted to extend the advantage entering upper stretch and held sway to the end under pressure. MUGHAADIR settled between foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, commenced a steady advance on the far turn while angling four wide racing into upper stretch and proved clearly best of the others. QUELCH, steadied in close quarters along the rail racing into the first turn, steadied again midway through that bend, shifted off the inside while being urged to advance on the far turn, shifted three wide in upper stretch and finished evenly late while prevailing for a share. MARDOCHAI tracked the pacesetter along the inside from just out of striking distance, saved ground to upper stretch but weakened in late stages. MY BOURBON BUY, bumped by AUD EDDIE then shut off at the start, was reserved while angling to the inside, shifted outside foes racing through the far turn and made an effort to improve position four deep in late stages. AUD EDDIE broke inwards bumping a rival, was urged to gain a forward placing three deep racing to the backstretch, chased the leader under pressure into the second bend and gave way nearing midstretch. LIFES REWARD, held up off the second flight while shifting inwards a bit racing into the first turn, was checked off rivals after clipping heels midway through the first bend and never menaced thereafter while making an effort to regain some position. WACKY INDIAN settled saving ground racing to the backstretch and offered no closing bid. KOBE'S CONQUEST tracked the leaders between foes in second flight in the opening stages, steadied while altering course in traffic midway through the first turn shifting into the path of LIFES REWARD and dropped out of contention early. SOUTHERN QUIET was urged to gain a contending position racing four deep to the backstretch but retreated early. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE INCIDENT ON THE FIRST TURN BUT NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
