**Footnotes**

MARCHING ORDERS tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance inside a rival in the opening stages, shifted outside that foe nearing the turn while making a steady advance to contention, shifted five wide in upper stretch while being roused to challenge, gained the advantage late and just held EMPIRE SHOES to the end under firm handling. The latter tracked off the second flight three deep racing to the turn, angled six wide in upper stretch and was making steady progress late. ROCKED tracked off the first flight in the opening stages, angled to the rail racing through the turn, came through close quarters while losing some position nearing midstretch and was just outkicked by the top pair. EXPLOSIVE WAR, forwardly placed three deep stalking just off the leaders, moved to challenge between foes in that path nearing midstretch and was just outkicked. LITTLE KICK, urged to force the pace outside a rival from the break, dueled for command to upper stretch and weakened between foes leaving the furlong marker. PETER LOUIS tracked off the second flight along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out racing into upper stretch and continued evenly between foes in late stages. STEEL HAMMER, held up in tight quarters just after the start, never gained contention. GRACIES BRUDDER was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival from the break racing into the bend and gave way leaving the furlong marker. KID CHIC was never a factor. SMARTY GRAS showed little.
