OF ALL TIMES tracked the leaders in second flight outside a rival under some reserve racing to the bend, swung out four wide entering upper stretch to challenge, wrested command leaving the furlong marker and went clear under firm encouragement. CAPTAIN CANAVERAL tracked the leaders in second flight along the inside, came through entering upper stretch to challenge along the rail, couldn't match the winner late but proved best of the others. DEATH VALLEY was urged to dispute the pace inside foes racing into the bend, gained a clear advantage after a half but failed to sustain his momentum. JEFF THE CLOCKER tracked the leaders near the inside while well out of striking distance, then continued along the inside to improve his position in late stages. UNBRIDLED ELTEMPO settled off the inside in the opening stages and passed outside some tiring rivals. CAMPO prompted the pace between foes from the outset, but faded steadily racing into upper stretch. GATHERING KINGS, prominent four wide early, pressed the issue three deep racing into the turn and gave way after a half.
