CABERNEIGH stalked the pacesetter outside a rival in the second flight under rating in the opening half, steadily moved to terms with the leader racing into upper stretch and prevailed in late stages under firm handling. ASTUTE moved clear along the inside racing to the first turn, dictated a measured pace on a clear margin to the second bend, resisted the winner's bid when challenged by that foe but came up second best. NAVY WINGS, reserved off the second flight along the inside racing to the far turn, shifted off the inside racing through the stretch and continued with a mild bid while earning a share. PRAIRIE BREEZE tracked the pacesetter inside a rival in the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. BIG AL settled off the second flight outside a rival, swung five wide racing into upper stretch but made no real impression. LEMONADE KID settled in last racing to the backstretch, was fanned six wide entering upper stretch but never seriously menaced. CORREDOR DELA ISLA tracked off the second flight outside a rival racing to the far turn but came up empty entering upper stretch.
