Footnotes

LUKE OF YORK, held up between foes in the second flight in the opening stages, shifted nearer to the inside entering the turn while making a steady advance on the leaders, split foes entering upper stretch to challenge for command between foes and turned back a challenge from HAMMERS TERROR in a prolonged drive to narrowly prevail under steady handling. The latter tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight in the opening stages, lost some position while angling out five wide nearing upper stretch, continued with a steady response to challenge for command near midstretch and was just outfinished. MY SILVER BEAR was reserved off the second flight near the inside early, saved ground on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and continued to improve his placing. CATFIDENTIAL, urged to the lead along the inside from the break, vied for command along the rail through the turn, but gave way midstretch when failing to fend off the top pair. D' TOPCAT broke a bit awkwardly, settled outside foes, angled six wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. ROJO VERDE, close up three deep between foes in the opening stages, continued in that path into the bend and faded after a half. BLUEGRASS TYPE broke inwards bumping HANDSOME HARBOR, was settled between foes in the opening stages and never gained contention. LITTLE MICHAEL shied outwards at the start bumping HANDSOME HARBOR, was settled near the inside racing to the turn and never seriously menaced. NORTHSCAPE, in close attendance to the pace four deep in the opening quarter, pressed the issue in that path racing into the turn and retreated after a half. HANDSOME HARBOR, bumped, then pinched back at the start, never menaced thereafter. HERO OF ORDER hopped at the start, was righted to chase the leaders along the inside into the turn but was spent early. PROUD JACKSON broke outwards, was urged along prompting a rival's pace racing into the turn but was through after a half.
