SMILIN' SLEW raced inside near the middle of the field, split horses in the stretch, rallied to the lead late and prevailed. ROCKCHALK JAYHAWK lacked speed, came out five wide for the drive and rallied through the stretch but missed. CANYON DE ORO raced off the rail near the middle of the field and gained belatedly. VIRTUAL G improved his position in the drive. GRIFTER raced close up off the rail and weakened. TOOMUCH CHAVEZ set the pace from the inside while pressed and tired. CROWD WATCHER pressed the pace just outside and also tired. DULCE DE LECHE was always outrun. (Race run in lane 2, rail at 0).
