Footnotes

PRAIRIE PRIZE broke sharply, was urged to set the pace on a narrow margin along the rail racing to the bend, moved away to a clear advantage nearing upper stretch and held sway to the end under steady prompting. XPECTION (NZ), reserved along the inside from behind the second flight in early stages, angled out three deep while being prompted to advance racing through the turn, shifted out four wide nearing upper stretch carrying out HAREM DANCER but continued with a steady effort to prevail for place honors. HAREM DANCER, in close attendance to the pace three deep in the opening stages, was eased off the leaders after the opening quarter to track those foes well off the inside, made some progress to regain contention while being floated out five wide in upper stretch, couldn't close the gap on the winner and was outfinished for second. OCEAN SURGE tracked off the first flight under light rating in the opening stages, angled to the rail entering the turn while briefly gaining striking distance but lacked the needed closing bid. GLORY CHASER, forwardly placed between foes tracking just off the pacesetter racing into the turn, steadily faded from contention after a half. WINE TASTING ROOM bobbled at the start, was settled outside foes, raced four wide into upper stretch but made no impression on the leaders. ABSOLUTELY ALI was never a factor.
