SCATTER A STAR broke inwards bumping a rival, was reserved out of striking distance along the inside in the opening half, steadily drew into contention while shifting off the inside racing through the far turn, switched out four wide entering upper stretch while being roused to challenge, then took charge and drew clear under firm handling. NAJJAAR settled outside foes racing to the backstretch, angled six wide entering upper stretch and made belated progress to prove best of the others. GOLDEN GIFT tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight under light rating in the opening half, advanced to challenge the leaders three deep entering the far turn, struck the front between calls nearing upper stretch but proved no match when confronted by the top pair. CONTROL TOWER settled outside foes in the opening stages, shifted out making brief progress four wide racing through the far turn, was fanned five wide entering upper stretch and finished evenly in late stages. EMPIRE TAKER, bumped, then pinched back at the start, settled along the inside racing to the second bend, shifted off the inside in upper stretch, angled five deep nearing the furlong marker but had no final bid. KID CHIC broke outwards bumping EMPIRE TAKER, was quickly righted to track the leaders along the inside in second flight racing to the far turn but steadily faded in the drive. PETER LOUIS, forwardly placed attending a rival's pace in the opening stages, pressed the issue between foes racing into the far turn and gave way nearing midstretch. PISGAH STATION tracked off the second flight off the inside in the opening half but dropped out entering the far turn. MY SAMURAI was urged

to the fore along the inside, set the pace racing into the far turn and emptied out nearing upper stretch.
