EXPLOIT THE SUN was fractious in the gate then rallied through traffic. SHE'S A GRINDER had no speed and closed willingly. HELLO JAKE raced in the second flight, drew even in the second turn and dropped back. DEL BONITA had no speed, raced widest in the lane and improved position. STORMY APRIL chased the pace, drew even in the second turn but failed to sustain the bid. WHATA TATTLE TALE was placed forwardly and faltered. AT THE FINISH set the pace under wraps, opened up to a large lead early and stopped in the stretch. RACE RUN IN LANE 1.
