Footnotes

TINNER joined the pace inside foes racing to the first turn, gained a narrow advantage entering the backstretch, dictated the pace into upper stretch and shook clear under steady pressure. FIRE CLOUD came through close quarters at the start to secure a forward placing along the inside, tracked just off the leaders into the far turn, shifted out nearing midstretch to challenge between foes, then came through tight quarters in the closing stages to edge a rival for the place. INTERNALACCOUNTING, close up three wide early, tracked the leaders outside a rival into the far turn, angled out to bid three deep entering the lane, continued to dispute second to late stages and was outfinished. SOLDERO moved to the fore, attended a rival's pace into the backstretch, pressed that rival on the far turn and gave way late. CULLINAN, reserved along the inside in the opening half, swung outside foes on the far turn, was fanned seven wide in the stretch but continued with interest to improve his placing. BAUERS GOT HOURS tracked just off the second flight along the inside to the far turn,

angled out to race six wide into upper stretch and continued evenly. COUNCIL OAK switched outside foes early to track the pace unhurried into the backstretch, passed some tiring rivals in the closing stages. HATTAASH settled along the inside in the opening half, saved ground to upper stretch while making some progress but was outkicked along the inside. TIME SENSITIVE raced unhurried out of striking distance into the far turn and offered no rally. WATER MILL tracked just off the second flight outside foes into the far turn but steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. STARTINGOLD tracked off the second flight along the inside to the backstretch but steadily faded on the far turn. MALIBU VICE was never a factor.
