EAGER EM, reserved near the inside for five furlongs, split foes while shifting just off the rail nearing upper stretch, switched out four wide entering the lane and produced a steady late response to wrest command and kick clear under energetic handling. SILVER ENCORE, reserved between foes in the last flight early, moved to striking distance with a steady four wide advance racing through the turn, struck the front nearing midstretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner. MISSION STORM broke outwards exchanging contact with LADY TROUBADOUR, was reserved off the second flight near the inside, steadied a bit off a rival in close quarters racing through the backstretch, came around a tiring foe then was urged to challenge nearest the rail racing into upper stretch, contested the issue past the furlong marker and was just outkicked. BACK LIKE A SONG tracked off the second flight outside foes racing to the turn and continued evenly four on the bend to late stages. KERRYCANONSUNDAY pulled her way to the fore along the inside early, set the pace on

a clear margin racing into the turn but gave way after being headed nearing midstretch. PUSHIN UP DAISY tracked the pacesetter outside foes in the second flight under light rating in the opening half, lodged a brief, three wide bid nearing upper stretch but quickly flattened out. LADY TROUBADOUR exchanged bumps with MISSION STORM at the start, was reserved well off the field to the turn, shifted outside some tiring foes racing into the stretch to gain some position but made no real impression. BUCKLE UP OUTLAW tracked the leaders five wide behind the second flight in the opening half and never gained contention. ZENINA exchanged bumps with CHITOWN LADY at the start, was guided to the inside to track just off the second flight racing into the turn but steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. MONA MONA was never a factor. CHITOWN LADY exchanged bumps at the start, recovered to gain a position in the second flight, chased the pacesetter into the turn but dropped out early. TEN LITTLE PINS was urged to gain a position outside a rival in the second flight, made a brief bid between foes nearing the turn but steadily retreated nearing upper stretch.
