NEXT SPEAKER shifted off the inside early tracking just off the pacesetter, made steady progress to challenge that foe racing into upper stretch, wrested command and kicked clear under firm encouragement. BOLD PERSPECTIVE angled inwards in the opening stages to gain a position between foes in the second flight, continued with a steady three wide advance racing into the stretch and secured the place honors. TAKE HEART, off last, settled off the second flight between foes, split rivals racing into upper stretch while shifting out four deep and found his best stride late to gain a share. MUPPET MAN was urged to gain the lead outside a rival soon after the break, angled to the rail once clear to dictate the pace, disputed the issue inside the winner into upper stretch and yielded in late stages. YANKEE INJUNUITY broke sharply while angling to the inside to track just off the leaders racing into the bend but faded racing through upper stretch. BARRACUDA BAY settled between foes in the opening stages and made some belated progress racing into the stretch. WEKIVA WACHEE settled last racing to the turn, shifted out four wide in upper stretch but proved no real threat. NO RULES NOW was a brief factor three deep in the second flight but retreated early.
