Footnotes

NORTH OF NEVER was rated out of striking distance tracking the leaders under light rating along the inside racing to the far turn, made steady progress while shifting out four deep nearing upper stretch, moved to wrest command approaching the furlong marker and was roused clear. BLAZING FINISH was rated off the leaders leading the second flight while angling inwards tracking the pace for five furlongs, shifted off the inside while advancing in tandem with the eventual winner to bid three deep between foes, couldn't match the winner but held a rival gamely for second. WILD JAZ was settled off the second flight in the opening half, shifted out four deep racing into upper stretch and produced a solid late response to close the gap while being just outfinished for place honors. BADGER BAY angled inwards to track the leaders between foes in the second flight, split rivals just off the inside to bid between foes racing into the stretch and was narrowly outkicked for a share. HEART DOCTOR joined the pace outside a rival to force the issue racing into the backstretch, angled to the rail once gaining the advantage entering the far turn, duelled for command inside foes to upper stretch and gave way. PIRALU was settled near the inside off the second flight early and never gained striking distance. AZURE DRAGON, bumped at the start, never gained contention. MYLES, forwardly

placed in the opening stages stalking the first flight, moved to challenge those foes three deep on the far turn but failed to sustain that momentum. RESPONSIVE EYE settled near the inside early but never gained contention. VINO LIMBO TANGO was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival racing to the backstretch, shifted outside the leader while continuing to dispute the issue between foes racing into the second bend but came up empty racing into upper stretch.
