Footnotes

KIDS RULE, reserved outside a rival in the last flight racing into the backstretch, dropped into last nearing the far turn while angling to the rail, switched off the inside nearing midstretch gathering momentum, accelerated sharply to contention splitting foes leaving the sixteenth marker and came through when presented an opening late, surging to command in time under brisk handling. FULL METAL was settled off the second flight while angling nearer to the inside racing to the backstretch, steadily drew into contention while shifting out five wide in upper stretch, shifted inwards under pressure in late stages

making some light contact with URBAN COOL nearing the wire but continued with interest to the end to narrowly gain the place honors while just failing to match the winner's final kick. SECOND CORINTHIANS was urged to join the pace three deep between foes racing into the first turn, drifted out entering that bend carrying out MIGHTY BROWN, maintained striking distance three deep racing into the backstretch, was urged to press the issue between foes nearing upper stretch, gained the advantage between calls late, drifted out under left handed pressure bumping MIGHTY BROWN approaching the wire and just failed to contain the top pair while continuing willingly to the end. EX PIRATE was guided to the rail early to track just off the first flight, pulled his way to terms with the first flight entering the backstretch, then was rated along the inside tracking just off the leaders entering the second bend, came through close quarters to challenge for command between foes near the inside racing into upper stretch, disputed the issue past midstretch and was just outfinished. MIGHTY BROWN, in touch with the first flight four deep racing into the first turn, was floated a bit wide entering that bend, was reserved off the first flight into the backstretch tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance for five furlongs, shifted out three deep nearing upper stretch to challenge for command between foes, was bumped by SECOND CORINTHIANS and forced into the path of URBAN COOL approaching the wire and gave out in the final strides. A STEP AHEAD, off slowly, was settled along the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out entering upper stretch and continued evenly between foes to gain some position while making no real impression. SILVER ROCKET MAN, reserved saving ground to the backstretch, shifted out racing into the lane but offered no closing response. REBEL SOUL angled to the rail racing into the first turn while being prompted to set the pace, pressed the issue inside foes racing into the far turn and gave way nearing midstretch. URBAN COOL was steadied avoiding close quarters while being prompted to gain a position just off the first flight racing into the first turn, tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance to the far turn, shifted out four deep nearing upper stretch while being prompted to advance, continued in that path between foes past midstretch, then was bumped, squeezed while losing his rider approaching the wire. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN AND DISQUALIFIED FULL METAL FROM SECOND FOR INTERFERENCE, PLACING HIM NINTH AND ALSO DISQUALIFIED MIGHTY BROWN FROM FIFTH FOR INTERFERENCE, PLACING HIM EIGHTH
