BAILAR lacked speed inside, angled out for the drive and rallied for a late decision. CHILLING EFFECT raced close up three wide, rallied to a short lead in the stretch and just failed to last. PURPLE HILLS lacked speed, angled out six wide for the drive and rallied belatedly. RUN WILLA RUN set the pace from the inside while pressed and weakened. THUNDER AND RAIN raced near the middle of the field and lacked a rally. TWILIGHT GLOW pressed the pace just outside and tired. DOC'S LEADING LADY was never a factor. SUGAR BIEN lacked speed and showed little. POSSULETTA SUE raced near the middle of the field and gave way. DYNAWAVE raced close up inside and tired. DO US PROUD gave way after a half.
