MOONLIGHT SONATA was allowed to settle outside while void of speed, began a rally on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, rallied in the stretch and won going away. PARTING lacked speed off the rail, moved up three wide on the turn, rallied to a narrow lead in the stretch then could not hold off the bid of the winner. SOURIS raced close up in good position three wide, rallied to challenge near the furlong marker then could not finish with the top one and narrowly lost the place. GLACIAL VICTOIRE was void of early speed, gained gradually, angled out for the drive and rallied belatedly in the stretch. BOLARO stumbled at the start, recovered to race close up inside then lacked a rally. EXPLOSIVE BEAUTY lacked speed, made a bid on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and faltered. ASHRAAF lacked speed and was never a factor. WILDCAT ANNIE set the pace from the inside under pressure and tired. GOLDEN DAYJUR had no speed and showed little. COMPETITIVE EDGE was always outrun. SEA BLOOM gave way in the drive. CLASSIC MOMENT pressed the pace from between horses and tired. DAYLIGHT ROBBERY was through early.
