E T PHONE LAURA raced close up just outside, rallied in the stretch and drew off under moderate encouragement. WAVERING RHYTHM lacked speed, angled out seven wide for the drive, rallied in the stretch and gained the place while no threat to the top one. CLOUD HARBOR raced close up inside and rallied mildly in the late going. ASHLEY G pressed the pace from off the rail and weakened. MAYBE LIN lacked speed and made a bid in the stretch but flattened out. SPARKY DIAMOND made a four wide bid on the turn but faltered in the drive. MESSINGER raced outside near the middle of the field, tired and passed tired ones late. CALL FOR HONOR raced three wide and tired. CONCERNINA set the pace from the inside while pressed and tired. NATIVE TRINKET was through early.
