Footnotes

JOHAR IRISH, urged to gain a clear advantage racing into the first turn, dictated the pace in hand to the second bend, maintained that advantage to upper stretch and held sway to the end under steady pressure. DOUBLE CROSSING (IRE) the leader inside foes in the second flight, made steady progress to gain position along the rail racing into the stretch and proved best of the others. CLASSIC RECITAL tracked off the second flight outside a rival under light rating in the opening half, was urged to advance three deep between foes racing through the far turn, couldn't menace the winner but continued with interest

to prevail for a share. KIPSON tracked the pace outside a rival in the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted to the inside on the far turn, continued inside foes into the stretch but lacked the needed final kick. SIR KIPLING, caught in tight quarters just after the start, settled off the second flight a bit off the inside, was caught four wide racing through the far turn while being prompted to advance but had no final bid. MR. GOLF, reserved along the inside in the opening half, swung out six wide racing into upper stretch to gain some position late while making no real impression. HEAD OF STATE settled into stride off the inside in the opening stages and continued evenly four wide between foes racing through the stretch. SHOT AN A GOAL settled outside a rival in the last flight racing to the backstretch, was caught five wide on the far turn and lacked a closing response. PICKY PICKY, held up avoiding tight quarters just after the break, was a bit rank under restraint between foes while rated off the second flight, then continued three deep between foes in some traffic racing into the stretch while lacking a closing response. KELPIE, forwardly placed tracking the pacesetter, was urged to lodge a brief bid entering the far turn but quickly retreated. TRICKEROY, reserved saving ground in the opening stages, steadily faded from contention on the far turn.
