**Footnotes**

HOLIDAY LUNCH gained a position just off the first flight while under firm rating racing through the backstretch, was urged to advance splitting foes when presented an opening nearing upper stretch, quickly moved away to a clear advantage under pressure racing through upper stretch and was taken in hand in late stages after the issue was decided. COWBOY LEGACY broke inwards a bit, was pulling against restraint along the inside racing into the turn, shifted out nearing upper stretch to split foes, couldn't gain terms with the winner but proved clearly best of the others. DUELING OAKS, urged to the lead along the inside from the break, dueled for command racing into the turn and gave way entering upper stretch when failing to match the top pair. TOP LINE broke inwards crossing the path of CALL M'VEE MAYBE, was righted to the leaders a bit off the inside racing into the turn but offered no rally. CALL M'VEE MAYBE broke awkwardly, then steadied out of close quarters just after the break, shifted outside foes while being hustled to contention, forced the pace outside a rival racing into the bend but was spent early.
