Footnotes

TWO LIONS, prominent between foes in the opening stages, dropped off the leaders after the opening quarter to track the pace unhurried, continued with a steady bid racing three deep into upper stretch and produced a solid late response to wrest command from BELL'S MAMBO approaching the wire under firm left handed encouragement. The latter shifted inwards bumping BOUND TO GOSSIP at the start, was righted to secure a forward placing along the inside, made steady progress while shifting outside the pacesetter nearing upper stretch to close the gap on the leader, gained the advantage between calls in late stages but just failed to contain the winner's final bid. RUNNINGOUT OF CASH, urged to secure the lead outside foes in the opening stages, went well clear racing into the turn, held sway to the furlong marker but failed to sustain his momentum. BAILOUT BUDDY worked his way to the inside racing through the backstretch while dropping off the second flight, shifted out three deep entering upper stretch and made an effort to improve position between foes. SERRATED EDGE, off last, settled into stride, angled out five wide racing into upper stretch and made some belated progress. PISTOL PERSUASION settled into stride along the inside tracking off the second flight, made some brief progress inside foes nearing upper stretch to gain some position but had no final bid. BROKEN BOW settled outside foes in early stages and never gained contention. BOUND TO GOSSIP, bumped at the start, settled between foes off the second flight and dropped out of contention early. RAILROAD TIE was under pressure racing through the backstretch in pursuit of the leaders racing nearest the rail and gave way entering upper stretch.
