MAGICAL MOMENT, within striking distance between foes in the opening stages, was eased off the leaders to track the pace outside a rival from out of striking distance for a half, was urged to advance four, then five wide leaving the far turn and continued with a steady late response to reel in DR BALLENGER in time under firm encouragement. The latter, forwardly placed along the inside racing to the first turn, shifted outside the pacesetter entering the backstretch, continued with a steady bid to challenge for command racing through the far turn, moved away to a clear advantage in upper stretch but couldn't quite contain the winner. CREATIVE WIZARD settled in last while working his way to the inside racing to the backstretch, made steady progress inside foes racing into upper stretch to gain contention but couldn't match terms with the top pair. DONT TOUCH MY GOLD broke inwards bumping A NICE SLEWISH BOY, was guided to the inside while dropping off the second flight racing to the backstretch, steadily drew into contention nearing the far turn, split foes, then was fanned four wide racing through the stretch and lacked the needed final response. CONTEMPORARY ART tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight racing to the far turn and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. A NICE SLEWISH BOY, bumped at the start, was settled off the second flight racing three deep to the backstretch and lacked a closing response. SOARING PEGASUS, off a bit slowly, tracked off the second flight along the flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out to race between foes on the second bend but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. CURZON STREET was urged to secure the lead outside foes racing into the first turn, angled over once clear nearing the backstretch, set the pace into the far turn and gave way once headed nearing upper stretch.
