### Footnotes

SON OF PEARL was rated three deep between foes off the second flight in the opening stages, readily advanced when prompted to challenge four wide racing into upper stretch, gained the advantage and went clear under firm encouragement. RADIANT DAY was settled out of striking distance racing off the inside early, shifted out on the bend and made steady progress five wide racing into upper stretch to prevail for place honors in time. PLUNDER angled inside early tracking just off the first flight, shifted off the rail to challenge between foes just off the inside entering upper stretch but lost some position when caught in close quarters nearing the furlong marker while continuing well enough to earn a share. BATTLE FACTS was urged to dispute the pace inside foes from the outset, continued to dispute the issue while shifting off the rail in upper stretch but weakened in the final sixteenth. SHOWBIZ IS MY BIZ was rated off the second flight along the rail racing into the bend, saved ground on the turn gaining some position after a half but had no final kick. SAILEN RAY J joined the pace four wide racing into the bend, pressed the issue on the turn to strike the front nearing upper stretch but gave way abruptly in upper stretch. THE GREEN COUGAR, reserved outside his entrymate in the opening stages, never gained contention. EVIL IMAGE tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing into the bend and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. HE GONE flashed brief pace three wide between foes but dropped out early. DIVER vied for command between foes from the outset racing into the turn but through after a half.
