COLLIN'S SMILE broke outwards bumping FLOOR MONEY, was righted, then reserved along the rail to take up a position behind the second flight racing to the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn while continuing under some restraint, shifted off the inside nearing midstretch, split foes to challenge inside the pacesetter and gained the advantage in time under pressure. UNDER REVIEW settled in last near the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out on the far turn splitting foes three deep, angled back to the rail nearing upper stretch while making steady progress, followed the winner's path through late stages and moved to challenge inside that foe nearing the wire while proving only second best. JACK N JOHN tracked the leaders under rating inside foes in the second flight racing to the far turn, made steady progress while shifting outside the leaders racing into upper stretch and continued willingly four deep to late stages to earn a share while just failing to match the top pair. ULTIMO TRAGO tracked the leaders three deep between foes in the second flight while racing in some close quarters to the backstretch, shifted out four wide leaving the far turn while being roused to challenge, gained the advantage entering upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum. FLOOR MONEY, bumped at the start, was urged to dispute the pace inside foes racing into the backstretch, continued in an extended skirmish into the second bend and gave way leaving midstretch. SMOKIN GLOCK tracked the leaders between foes near the inside in second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final bid. LOOSENTHESECONDARY, in touch with the first flight early, was eased off the pace to stalk the leaders into the backstretch, was urged to lodge a brief bid between foes nearing upper stretch but

quickly flattened out. LASSELL tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight racing to the far turn and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. COOL UNDER FIRE, caught four wide racing into the first turn while part of the second flight, never mounted a serious threat. JOHNNY HANDSOME settled into stride along the inside early and never seriously menaced. MR FLASHY was hustled outside foes forcing the pace into the first turn, continued to dispute the issue outside a rival to the second bend and emptied out abruptly midway through the far turn.
