BETHANY BELLE, forwardly placed stalking the pacesetter under light rating in the opening half, steadily moved to terms with the pacesetter on the far turn attending that foe's tempo, moved away to a clear advantage when prompted racing into upper stretch and held sway to the end under pressure. CRACKING GOOD PINS was rated along the inside in second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch while being roused to challenge making some contact with YOU BOUGHT HER and narrowly prevailed for place honors while failing to gain terms with the winner. FLATTERING TOUCH settled saving ground in the opening stages, shifted out racing into upper stretch bumping INCREDIBLE JOURNEY but continued willingly four deep to late stages to close the gap while edging a rival for a share. YOU BOUGHT HER tracked off the first flight a bit off the inside racing to the far turn, was urged to challenge three deep racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick while racing in some tight quarters late. COACHES CHOICE broke slowly, was settled along the inside, saved ground to upper stretch and displayed some mild interest late. PELIGROSA, caught four wide racing into the first turn, never gained striking distance. INCREDIBLE JOURNEY tracked the leaders three deep off the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out nearing upper stretch while being prompted to advance but lost her momentum when bumped in upper stretch and lacked the needed final response. FRONTIER DAYS urged to secure the lead along the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace to the second bend and gave way racing into upper stretch.
