

THUNDER BERTIE set the pace from the inside while pressed, took clear command turning for home and finished under a brisk hand ride after her rider lost the whip approaching the furlong marker. CARESSING pressed the pace of the winner from just outside, could not go with the winner on the turn, was displaced by ZAHWAH in the stretch then came back gamely for the place. ZAHWAH raced close up four wide, rallied closest to the winner in the stretch then could not gain on that one and weakened to lose the place late. GOLD HUNTRESS raced outside while not far back, moved up in the stretch then lacked the necessary late response. SCOOP saved ground near the middle of the field but failed to rally in the stretch. DARE SHE GOES lacked speed off the rail and was never a factor. TIME IS MONEY trailed to the stretch and passed beaten rivals. THE HESS EXPRESS raced close up and was through early. PIONJEWEL stumbled at the start and was always outrun. MONTANA CAT raced close up three wide but gave way in the drive.
