CINDY'S HOBBY raced close up off the rail, rallied to the lead in the stretch then was fully extended to last. SANDY BAY LADY raced just outside near the middle of the field, rallied in the final furlong and just missed. BRITTSKER vied for the lead just outside, appeared to jump a shadow on the turn and held on gamely in the drive. TRICKLE DOWN lacked speed and improved his position in the drive. SANDY'S WAY lacked speed and never reached a contending position. NANCYDANCING was never a factor. TABLE THE MOTION was always outrun. COME SEPTEMBER contested the pace inside and tired.
