ROCK SONG FIVE, pinched back at the start, settled into stride off the second flight racing through the backstretch, shifted out four wide nearing upper stretch while making steady progress and produced a sustained response to wrest command in time under firm left handed encouragement. ENGLISH ACCENT was rated tracking off the first flight near the inside in early stages, shifted out on the turn to challenge three deep racing into upper stretch, gained a brief advantage leaving the furlong marker but couldn't contain the winner's final bid. COURTESY CALL tracked the pace outside a rival in the second flight, lost some position racing into the bend, shifted outside foes racing into the stretch and found her best stride late to close the gap while earning a share. AUTUMN SPLENDOR, forwardly placed three deep in the opening stages, angled to the inside nearing the turn, saved ground to the lane but had no closing bid. SING IT OUT broke outwards bumping the eventual winner, was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival, gained the advantage to dictate the pace into upper stretch but gave way leaving the furlong marker. ISLET, forwardly placed prompting the pacesetter racing into the bend, gave way after a half. MIDNIGHT BRUISER was outpaced early.
