ADIOS NARDO, bumped at the start, was quickly righted, then urged to join the pace outside a rival, attended the tempo into the bend, pressed the issue into upper stretch and continued with a steady response to narrowly prevail under firm encouragement. VOUGH FOR VICTORY was urged to the lead along the inside from the break, disputed the pace into upper stretch, gamely resisted the winner's bid but came up second best. AL MUSADDAD angled to the inside early to track the leaders as part of the second flight, saved ground on the turn, shifted out in late stages and edged a rival for a share. DAD ARE WE HERE tracked the leaders three deep as part of the second flight racing to the turn, continued with a steady bid in that path into upper stretch and was just outfinished for a share. BLUE CANOE settled in last along the rail early, saved ground to upper stretch but continued with interest to improve position. BLUEGRASS JET tracked the pace outside foes off the second flight, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and had no closing bid. RIVERSHIRE broke inwards bumping the eventual winner, was settled between foes in the last flight racing into the turn and offered no rally. MI LUNA GRANDE tracked off the second flight between foes in the opening half and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. GRAND COMPOSER settled between foes in early stages and never mounted a serious challenge. SWORD AND SHIELD tracked the leaders along the inside behind the second flight racing into the bend and came up empty entering upper stretch.
