Footnotes

WEEPNOMOREMYLADY lacked speed between horses, rallied in the stretch and won going away. GLORIFY set the pace on a clear lead but could not hold off the winner in the drive. ART FAIR was void of speed then rallied belatedly along the rail in the stretch. FAST WAVE was bumped hard at the start, settled near the middle of the field and made a bid in the stretch but flattened out. CASHIER'S WAGER stalked the pace from off the rail and weakened. TO THE TEST broke in to bother foes, raced close up and weakened. REPLAY raced close up off the rail and tired. MS BODGIT was always outrun. LIGHT AS A CAT was bumped hard at the start causing her rider to lose the irons and was pulled to the rear on the turn. MS CLASSIC JONES gave way after a half.
