GENDER MOTORS stalked the pace from off the rail, rallied to the lead on the final turn, took clear command in the stretch and held sway under urging. YUKAN B A LADY TOO raced close up just outside, rallied three wide then could not get to the winner in the drive. GO GO HASTY saved ground near the middle of the field, angled out in the stretch and was gaining late. QUIP N JET lacked speed inside, moved off the rail for the drive and gained belatedly. SPRING OPEN was never a factor. RACING A PLENTY set the pace on a clear lead and tired. GREEN MILL raced off the rail and tired. NICKY D. TAYLOR broke down on the final turn.
