RUPERT'S FIRE also made a mild bid and faltered. BEAUTY SCHOOL was never a factor. ESTEEMED GUEST improved her position in the drive. WAVERING RHYTHM was never a factor. KAT CAN DANCE had early speed inside and tired. MONEY STRETCHER was always outrun. FRANKIE'S LADY raced close up but gave way in the drive. BEST MATE was also outrun.
