CAT GENIUS broke on top, set all of the pace from the inside on a clear lead and was not menaced while kept to urging. DESERT WARRIOR was void of speed while racing to the outside, rallied in the stretch and gained the place while no danger to the winner. OMEGA CODE stalked the pace of the winner from off the rail but could not stay with that one and lost the place in the final furlong. BATTLE TANK saved ground while always outrun. PRINCE IN COMMAND dropped back steadily from the inside.
