Footnotes

VOLPONI saved ground going into the first turn, moved between horses entering the backstretch, settled in good position for a mile, closed the gap leaving the far turn, waited briefly for room nearing the stretch, split rivals to get clear approaching the quarter pole, unleashed a powerful move to take charge in upper stretch, opened a commanding lead under right hand urging in mid stretch then drew off under a vigorous hand ride. MEDAGLIA D'ORO moved up from outside going into the first turn, stalked the pace while four wide along the backstretch, closed the gap from outside leaving the three-eighths pole, made a run to challenge on the turn, was unable to match strides with the winner in upper stretch but continued on willingly to hold for the place. MILWAUKEE BREW dropped back soon after the start, saved ground while racing well back along the backstretch, swung out on the turn, launched a rally four wide between horses entering the stretch then closed late to narrowly miss for the place. EVENING ATTIRE broke a bit slowly, raced well back for a mile, circled four wide on the turn, angled wider in upper stretch then rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. MACHO UNO angled to the inside approaching the first turn, was reserved while between horses along the backstretch, angled five wide while gaining a bit on the turn then lacked a strong closing response. DOLLAR BILL trailed a good portion of the trip while saving ground then improved his position with a late run along the inside. HAWK WING raced well back after breaking slowly, lodged a mild rally while six wide on the turn then flattened out. WAR EMBLEM moved up from outside to contest the early pace, forced the pace for seven furlongs, gained a brief lead between horses on the turn then faltered in the stretch. HARLAN'S HOLIDAY failed to mount a serious rally. CAME HOME raced within striking distance while four wide for seven furlongs then steadily tired thereafter. E DUBAI sprinted clear in the early stages, set a brisk pace along the inside for a mile then gave way. PERFECT DRIFT raced up close along the inside for seven furlongs

and tired.
