Footnotes

HERO'S TRIBUTE stalked the pace from just off the rail, went up to challenge BALTO STAR on the final bend, took command turning for home and drew off under moderate encouragement. BALTO STAR broke in good order, set the pace from the inside, took clear command on the backstretch then could not hold off the winner while continuing gamely tot the wire. SILVER ZIPPER was void of speed while off the rail, rallied outside into the second turn but lacked a further response in the drive. GENEROUS ROSI (GB) brushed with RACE ON GREEN shortly after the break, lacked speed and was never a factor. ON YOUR MARK was void of speed and was always outrun. RACE ON GREEN was brushed after the break, raced close up three wide and was through after a half.
