SUPERNAL rated along inside, angled out in upper stretch and was along late from the outside. RHINESTONE DEWEY raced close up inside, came wide for the drive and stayed on gamely to the finish. ALWAYS TRY LOVE rated inside, split rivals in the stretch and finished gamely. CAJUN SEASON raced wide and stayed on gamely through the stretch. EXPLOSIVE AMY set the pace and stayed on well along the inside. GABAROUSE steadied on the first turn, pressed the pace from the outside and weakened in the final furlong. SISTER BERTIE stumbled at the start and lacked a rally. CIGAR CHARLIE chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch.
