GAINANGO quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside, drew away to a long lead when roused then held on under a drive. TALKIN TOUGH was bumped at the start, chased the pace and finished gamely outside. BLUESMAN was pinched back at the start, dropped back early and finished well outside. GONE TO BE KING was bumped at the start, chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. NORTHERN STEALTH raced wide throughout and lacked a rally. POLISH POSH was bumped at the start, raced inside and tired in the stretch. ROSE'S SUNSHINE stumbled at the start, was bumped and lacked a rally. BRIAN'S A PRO was bumped at the start, was outrun early and had no response when roused. SAND KING was bumped at the start and tired. SENOR GATOR bobbed at the start and had no rally. TWICE AS ROYAL was finished early. GINSTONE tired after showing brief speed.
