C C'S PAL was put to a firm hold after the break, contently stalked the front runners while kept at a slight distance from the rail, continued on the same scenario for nearly six furlongs, began to pick up interest late on the far turn, in preparation for the stretch run, angled under encouragement to be three wide at the head of the stretch and took off in earnest after the pair just up ahead, appeared to be the first of a tightly-bunched trio to reach the eighth pole, the outermost member of this group, edged away the final furlong, crossing the wire under a brisk hand ride. BAHAMA BOUND patiently stalked the pacesetter from the two path until approaching the quarter pole, responded ;positively when given her cue, bid between foes for a good portion of the run through the furlong grounds, failed to keep pace with the winner after that one took over, but finished with good courage to win the battle for place honors. KATY NOW away alertly, grabbed the early lead and dashed over to the rail, was rated while setting the opening splits, got called upon as the pressure intensified nearing the top of the stretch, fought with the top pair from nearly the quarter pole to the furlong marker, then got out kicked by each. ONE LAST DANCE off the inside, swung three wide into the stretch, proved no match. FOOLS IN LOVE unsettled, leapt at the start, rode the rail, cut the corner under strong handling, but made no gain.
