NICOLE H sat well reserved, remained under a firm hold, wedged in between rivals and stuck in traffic from midway on the turn until the three-sixteenths pole, availed of room and tipped to be outside of the front runners at that station, displayed good acceleration rolling by WINNING IMAGE to take over in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, kept a neck in front thereafter under confident handling. WINNING IMAGE established control soon after the start, showed the way, rated while placed slightly off the inside, got asked for a response as the pressure increased approaching the quarter pole, held her ground well during the ensuing furlong, got overhauled by the top one less than a sixteenth later, tried valiantly but couldn't re gain command. AQUITANIA tracked the leader from the pocket, angled outward during the run through the furlong grounds, proved no match for either of the first two finishers en route for show honors. ISN'T SHE GRAND was lightly hand urged from the gate to secure a forward position, patiently prompted the pacesetter from the two path for a half, weakened steadily during the stretch drive. BOLD AFFAIR was let out a notch after departing the backstretch, left the five-sixteenths pole strung out in the four wide, failed to fire when fully called upon. DON'TGETSUSPICIOUS raced three wide and tired.
