NICOLE H was grabbed hold after coming out a step at the break, took up position in the two path, remained under a firm hold as the pilot was forced to await suitable options heading for the quarter pole, inched her way slightly wider after turning for home, had sufficient clearance at the three-sixteenths pole and split rivals, doing so while yet unasked seriously for run, poked a head down in front with an eighth to go, edged away, lightly ridden out. MILDLY OFFENSIVE assumed a forward position soon after the start, prompted the pacesetter from the outside, firmly rated by the rider until about midway on the turn, cranked up the pressure, joined in the task by TANGLEWOOD TALE, got let out a notch and secured the front, led the field into the stretch holding a narrow advantage, with all of the others still in close proximity and in hot pursuit, had the lead snatched away by the confidently-ridden winner in midstretch, continued onward willingly for the place. SINGLET underwent a four wide pursuit, backed away but outfinished a tiring pair for the show award. TANGLEWOOD TALE sat forwardly placed three wide, ranged up to increase her presence during the later stages of the run around the bend, challenged in earnest at the quarter pole, but soon flattened out. SILENT SERENITY rushed up leaving the starting gate under her own power to gain the early advantage, led a tightly-packed group while taking the inside route, was put to a severe test after going slightly more than halfway around the turn, succumbed turning for home and faltered.
