Footnotes

PRINCESS MARA away with no apparent mishap, quickly established control, was down along the inside before reaching the end of the homestretch, got rated along setting the pace, only facing some resistance from the primary pursuer between the calls down the backstretch, began to edge from that foe upon reaching the far turn, got put to a drive spinning into the stretch, emerged from the furlong grounds having built up the lead to a comfortable margin and went on to maintain it, kept to active handling. HOUSE ON TOILSOME broke last after lunging up as the field was sent on its way, was guided over to the rail and rode it until approaching the five-sixteenths pole, pilot atop with a firm grip on the reins during the initial phases, slipped into the two path during the later stages of the run around the far turn, arrived at the quarter pole and got asked for run coming into the stretch, couldn't gain on the winner and had to settle for the place. LILY LYNN strung out three wide on the second bend, lacked the necessary stretch response. ROCK SHOW saved ground and made no impact. C C'S PRIDE took the inside route, failed to pick up speed or interest despite being asked to do so by the five-sixteenths marker. BOZIQUE raced along the outside, got set down past the three-eighths pole, folded. SUS ANNMARIES GOLD three wide heading for the beginning of the opening bend, worked out a tuck into the two path at its midway point, accompanied the winner from the two path for the first half, fell back steadily leaving the half mile pole. MALIBU QUEEN in the three path on the first turn, was closer to the rail on the next one, gave way.
