Footnotes

CRAFTY N P sprinted clear on the rail, extended her lead in upper stretch and held sway under steady urging. DIVORCE COURT was rated along the inside for a half, split horses in midstretch and closed late to gain the place. TAINTEDLOVE stalked three wide for a half, took up chased after the winner in upper stretch but wasn't quite good enough. SEVENTEEN LOVE steadied in tight at the start, saved ground for a half, steadied along the inside leaving the turn and rallied belatedly. CITY BY SEA pressed the winner between horses, remained a factor into midstretch and steadied behind horses while tiring in deep stretch. ALCHERA was well placed in the two path and lacked a rally. AMONGOOSEAMONGUS bobbed after being bumped leaving the gate and was never a factor while five wide. PELELIU never reached contention while four wide.
