Footnotes

WOLFSON patiently pursued the pacesetter three wide, remained within striking distance during the run around the bend, was given his cue in upper stretch, ranged up to the leader, then wore down that foe despite being carried out during the final furlong. MISSILE MOTOR established command soon after the start, carved the fractions while travelling in the two path, was put a drive after entering the stretch, grudgingly yielded the lead in the final yards, while drifting out noticeably leaving the eighth pole, despite receiving strong right handed encouragement. INDEPENDENCE WAR ducked inward midway around the turn, commenced a clear rail rally in upper stretch, grabbed a narrow lead approaching the sixteenth pole, going past a troubled WOLFSON and a drifting MISSILE MOTOR, maintained it before getting outkicked by that pair in the late stages. ELTISH STAR kept in reserve during the opening half, was fanned five wide into the stretch, failed to rally appreciably. MITCHELL PARK saved ground to no avail. UNBRIDLED DANGER raced four wide around the turn and tired. NORTH BEND was outrun, then returned bleeding. HURRICANE HEAT was always outrun.
