**Footnotes**

GOLD VENDETTA reserved for a half while travelling four wide around the turn, came six wide into the lane, responded with good energy once roused, sped past rivals during the stretch run, took charge and drew clear. FIDDLERS PATRIOT stumbled after being bumped at the start, was unhurried, drafting in the three path behind rivals during the run around the bend, was fanned five wide turning for home, advanced into a contending position by the time he reached the eighth pole, couldn't match the top one during the final eighth but on with good courage to take the place. AL'S LARK pressed the pace from the outside, kept up the pressure after entering the stretch, grabbed a short lead but failed to sustain the bid. BROCK N ROLL displayed a good late rally along the outside. KING DAVID J raced four wide, remained a prominent factor before weakening during the final furlong. WINGNUT between rivals, lacked a solid stretch bid. AL'S DEPUTY outran for a half, improved his position during the stretch drive. SOUTH BRONX saved ground to no avail. HEIR TO THE STONE three wide, tired after a half. STRUMMER bumped at the start, rode the rail, was forced to steady in traffic leaving the three-sixteenths pole and offered little thereafter. WILLIAM THOMAS set the pace along the inside, retreated after a half.
