MAGIC MAX away well from the starting gate, established command soon after the start, was rated on a loosely-contested lead while taking the inside route, extended the advantage approaching the quarter pole, still unasked until about a sixteenth down the road, continued on the front with a steadily diminishing lead, but managed to reach the finish line in time to preserve the decision. MIND BOGGLING off to a poor beginning, after breaking in a tangle, encountered further trouble a couple of strides later, getting lightly bumped by another rival, recovered and quickly angled over to take up position along the inside, bided time from there before being asked to pick up the pace coming to the five-sixteenths pole, angled outward, having now built up some momentum, maintained it, gaining readily on the front runners during the run through the furlong grounds, then finished with good energy during the final sixteenth, but ran out of the needed real estate to collar a weakening leader. QUICK MONEY patiently stalked the leader from the outside under a firm hold, was called upon for a response at the five-sixteenths pole after losing position to that foe, gained gradually the entire length of the stretch but wasn't good enough. TOUGH JUSTICE lightly bumped between rivals at the start, was put to encouragement on the turn, but got outkicked. DUCALE was lightly bumped at the start, took up chase three wide under encouragement and folded. GERARD LOVES BEER lightly bumped at the start, was strung out four

wide at the half mile pole and weakened after completing the opening half. PARKINSON FIELD grabbed hold of after breaking outward, proceeded to veer inward thereafter, impeding several rivals as a result, raced off the inside thereafter and failed to threaten. MOCHACHINO bumped after the start, went three wide around the turn and tired. SMOKIN CONRAD was checked after being bumped by an errant rival soon after the start, raced well off the inside and gave way. SAGA CITY was no menace.
