SMART STRIDE broke out a bit at the start, was coaxed early down the backstretch to rejoin the pack, sat patiently in the three path behind rivals, found room and availed of the opportunity to angle outward coming to the five-sixteenths pole, spun four wide into the stretch and commenced to rally in earnest, grabbed control before reaching the eighth pole and kicked clear, crossing the finish line under a brisk hand ride. BLONDECAT chased the front runners from the two path, ducked to the inside in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, launched a mild rally to be along for the place. TRUTH WILL TELL grabbed hold at the break was off a beat slowly, picked up the pace during the later stages of the run around the bend, entered two wide and under encouragement into the stretch and displayed a mild kick en route for the show. CELTIC CHANT disputed the pace from the two path and weakened in the final furlong. SOCIAL STATEMENT contested the pace three wide for the opening half before backing away. HILLSBORO BAY departed the backstretch from the four path and folded. MS DILLER vied for the front from the inside during the initial stages, then faded.
