WISE GUIDE three wide on the first turn, advanced into a strong contending position racing down the backstretch, continued in the three path for most of the way around the far turn, was let out turning for home now in possession of a very slim advantage, found a resolute foe in ONE FOR DON and was unable to shake that one off during the ensuing furlong, with the runner up now looming a serious threat as well at that juncture, got engaged in a duel with that rival shortly afterwards, came out after some left handed stick work in the final seventy yards, both carrying out and making light contact with the runner up, dug in with determination to prevail. GRAHAMANDWITHERS sat loosely pocketed during the initial stage, was asked for run angling three wide into the stretch, closed in readily on the front runners, drew alongside the winner soon after departing the eighth pole, got both herded out and brushed by an errant WISE GUIDE in the late stages and fell short. ONE FOR DON took charge shortly after the start and was sent over to the inside route, proved ratable setting the opening fractions on a loosely-contested lead, fell an increase in the pressure upon entering the far turn, yielded as the three-quarters was being completed despite being under a drive, remained a stubborn rival for an additional eighth before backing away. DENN PIPER was maneuvered into the middle of the strip down the backstretch, unleashed a run from slightly more than the three wide on the far turn to scurry into contention, lost some ground and momentum drifting out during the initial stages of the stretch drive, ignoring right handed pressure being applied by the rider as a countermeasure, flattened out in the last eighth. I'M WIDE AWAKE stalked the leader from the two path, was already being asked for run by the five-sixteenths marker. CLOSINGTOTHETWIRE sent over to the rail at the end of the backstretch, had no response. FLOWING MANE in the three path on each bend, was no factor. PEGASUS RED three wide on the first turn, tired.
